

## Wash and Wax Instructions

### Post-Flight Cleaning

- Spray down the leading edge surfaces with WashWax All and let it soak 5-10 minutes. Respray the surface and use the Aero Scrubber pad to break up any bugs and other debris. Wipe the area dry with the blue microfiber cloth.
- Spray a healthy amount of Plexi-Clear on the outside of the windows and let it soak for a few minutes to soften up any remaining debris. Wipe clean with a microfiber towel.

### Monthly Wash-and-wax

#### Airframe

- Use the hoses to spray down the upper surfaces of the aircraft to help remove the heaviest and dried out debris, and use the white towels to dry off the surfaces
- Use the spray bottles to spray non-diluted WashWax All on all upper and lower surfaces, using the white towels to clean and dry off the surfaces. *Do not use* any towels that were used to clean the aircraft belly on any other surface!

#### Windows

- Soak the windows with water to remove bugs and dust/dirt/etc that have been on the windows for a while, and use a microfiber towel to dry it off and remove the remaining debris
- Spray a healthy amount of Plexi-Clear on the outside of the windows and let it soak for a few minutes to soften up any remaining debris. Wipe clean with a microfiber towel. Do the same for the interior, except you can skip the soaking period.

### Additional Pre-Open House Detailing

#### Oxidized Paint

- Apply a small amount of Top Gun to a terry towel and rub in small circles until the haze disappears

#### Non-oxidized Paint

- Use non-diluted WashWax All on the aircraft surfaces and the microfiber towels to clean and dry the surface

### Wash and Wax Notes

- Automotive waxes containing carnauba and silicones can cause a buildup of static electricity
- Treating carpets with a fiber protectant makes it more stain resistant
- **Do not use *any* cleaner on the windows that contains acetone or ammonia!**
- **Do not use** paper towels or shop rags to clean the windows!
